The colour on this wine is very deep and dark suggesting small crop and intense flavours. This intensity carries through in the glass with powerful dark plum aromas lifted by good French oak. The palate opens up and shows firm, ripe tannins that enhance the plum and overall intense fruit flavours. A good richly textured, richly flavoured shiraz with an opportunity for a further two years bottle development.
