Mount Avoca Semillon Sauvignon Blanc 2003 (\$15)
The traditional white blend from Bordeaux has done exceptionally well in the west and also succeeds here in this mid-Victorian effort, though the result is more tropical than the typical WA classics. Drink while young. Drink with: tempura.

The colour is pale to very pale straw. This blend is very much Semillon driven with aromas of citrus peel and some perfume, as well as a hint of tropical fruit character. The palate opens up well with good crisp and almost savoury characters in the centre. The finish is finely textured with a little kick of acid for freshness. This is a food wine that can cope with powerful Asian flavours. Drink now rather than cellar.
